

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS POST DOCTORAL POSITION 2020

I. PRESENTATION

The Institute of Public Affairs (INAP) at the University of Chile (INAP) invites national or foreign academics that obtained their PhD in the previous 5 years to apply for a postdoctoral position at the Institute, in Santiago, Chile. The one-year position is scheduled to start on March 9, 2020.

INAP is formed by academics specializing in areas of public affairs gathered in multidisciplinary research groups in political science, public administration, public safety and public policies. This call for applications aims to strengthen the Institute's academic development by bringing scholars that contribute to interdisciplinary academic debate.

Preference will be given to applicants whose research interests connect with one of the following areas:

- Political institutions
- Public safety
- State reform
- Political and social actors and movements

The individual selected is expected to have full time commitment to his/her research project. It too is expected that she or he will teach one undergraduate or graduate level course in one of the two semesters of the academic year and to make two research presentations (at the start and the end of the academic year).

Required documents are:

1. Currículum vitae (including a copy of certificates of academic degree)
2. Letter explaining interest in the position (one page)
3. Postdoctoral research proposal (six pages maximum)
4. Two academic references (name and e-mail address)

III. SELECTION PROCESS

STAGES	DATES
applications	Until 17 January 2020
Evaluation and selection	9 working days since application deadline. This stage is conducted by a three-member selection committee of INAP faculty members. The committee will conduct interviews of those in the preselected group.
End of selection process	31 January 2020

IV. FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The position contemplates a monthly compensation (12 months) of CLP\$ 1.800.000 (approximately US\$ 28,000 annually, pending on exchange rate variation).
